NOTES DURING CORONAVIRUS OUTBREAK: Dear saints, please remember that we continue to observe social distancing of 2 meters and masking orders of our town and province. Next week we will begin to use the chalice for the distribution of our Lord's blood. Our practice of wiping and turning the cup helps to limit the transmission of communicable diseases and we are investigating additional methods of wiping the cup to prevent the spread of viruses. If you are looking to receive the Lord's blood from the chalice, simply politely refuse the individual cup and pastor will come by with the chalice. It is requested that you keep your individual cup visible so that pastor knows you have already received the blood of Christ.
