LENTEN MERCY: This Lent we will be working to support the crisis pregnancy centre: Our Lady of Guadalupe Home (OLOGH). OLOGH is the only residential home for young single mothers in Windsor. They have been open since 2013. Their centre can house up to 7 moms and their babies. Today, after the service we will be having a representative from Guadalupe Home join us after our service for a special presentation on the centre. Their biggest need at the moment is funding to replace mattresses, couches, stoves, dishwasher, etc. If you would like to contribute to OLOGH you can write it in on your offering envelope and Good Shepherd will forward the money to them.
