STEWARDSHIP BLURB: Luke 13:13 – "No, I tell you; but unless you repent, you will all likewise perish." The season of Lent is all about repentance. It is about turning back to the Lord, away from our sins, in faith. We know that it is only in the Lord that we can find salvation. So, we do well in this season of repentance to examine ourselves, asking questions like, "What is trying to keep me away from Jesus? What is a temptation I face? What is a sin I need to repent of and leave behind?" Then we turn to the Lord for the strength to leave these sins behind, and we turn to the Lord for the courage to follow Him in faith and faithful living.

SUNDAY BIBLE STUDY: Our Sunday Bible study takes place in the sanctuary at 9:30 a.m. Everyone is welcome as we will be talking about the lost & found parables in Luke 15. What we see as being three different parables Luke introduces as one parable.

WEDNESDAY BIBLE STUDY: We are back to meeting together this week. We will continue our wrap up of Hebrews 7 and move into Hebrews 8. Here the preacher is making some final

points on the superiority of the priesthood of Jesus as the one who lives forever and offers His own blood to enter into the heavenly sanctuary and remain there as our intercessor. LENTEN MERCY: This Lent we will be working to support the crisis pregnancy centre: Our Lady of Guadalupe Home (OLOGH). OLOGH is the only residential home for young single mothers in Windsor. They have been open since 2013. Their centre can house up to 7 moms and their babies. Their biggest need at the moment is funding to replace mattresses, couches, stoves, dishwasher, etc. If you would like to contribute to OLOGH you can write it in on your offering envelope and Good Shepherd will forward the money to them.
