They're all part of one service that concludes on Easter Sunday with the celebration of our Lord's resurrection, which we celebrate at 10:30 a.m. Members are encouraged to make use of the invitations at the table in the narthex where we have our bulletins to invite friends, neighbours, and family to our Holy Week services.
