THE LUTHERAN HOUR: “Can I Get a Witness?” (Luke 24:48) How did Christianity become the dominant faith of Western civilization? It's partly arithmetic, but mostly, it isn't. STEWARDSHIP BLURB: Luke 24:6-7 – “He is not here, but has risen. Remember how he told you, while he was still in Galilee, that the Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men and be crucified and on the third day rise.” Jesus is risen. But is that Good News? What if He is mad at us for betraying Him, for running away at Gethsemane, for not believing He would rise? The Good News is not just that Jesus is risen; the Good News is that He is risen to bless us. There is no need to be alarmed. He still calls us His friends and brothers and sisters, and He means to bring us through death to resurrection as well. The Lord is risen – He is risen indeed!

SUNDAY BIBLE STUDY: Our Sunday Bible study will be taking a break for Easter Sunday. Next week we are going to be meeting together to talk about Jesus passing His authority to forgive sins to His apostles on earth and then ask the question: where was Thomas?
