STEWARDSHIP BLURB: Luke 20:16 – “ ‘He will come and destroy those tenants and give the vineyard to others.’ When they heard this, they said, ‘Surely not!’ ” The crowds were shocked at Jesus’ parable because they took the grace of God for granted. They never thought that God would actually take “the vineyard” away from them. But we only have access to God by faith. And we can drive faith and the Holy Spirit away. That is the warning of the parable. The Lord has graciously given us His Kingdom. Let us not take it for granted but instead respond with humble thanksgiving!

SUNDAY BIBLE STUDY: Our Sunday Bible study takes place in the sanctuary at 9:30 a.m. Everyone is welcome next week as we now enter into Holy Week with Palm Sunday. Jesus begins the most important week of His life.

WEDNESDAY BIBLE STUDY: We will be meeting this week before taking a one week break for Holy Week. We are moving into Hebrews 8 where we will be discussing the superiority of the sacrifices of Jesus' priesthood that makes the first covenant obsolete and put away. We currently meet both in person and online on Google Meet. If you would like the Google Meet link, please ask Pastor.

HOLY WEEK SERVICES: Holy Week begins next Sunday. We will holding services on Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday. We will commemorate Maundy Thursday with the Divine Service that concludes with the stripping of the altar at 7:00 p.m. Good Friday is the remembrance of our Lord's Passion with the Chief Service at 7:00 p.m. A keen observer will not that neither of these two services conclude with a blessing. That's because they don't technically end. They're all part of one service that concludes on Easter Sunday with the celebration of our Lord's resurrection, which we celebrate at 10:30 a.m. Members are encouraged to make use of the invitations at the table in the narthex where we have our bulletins to invite friends, neighbours, and family to our Holy Week services.

LENT SERVICES: Our Lent services conclude this Wednesday at 12:00 p.m. Members who attend are invited to join us afterwards in the gym to enjoy a bagged lunch together. We will be using a series for our services written by former ABC District President Don Schieman on the passion of Christ and reading a harmony of the four gospels on the passion of Christ. If you would like a Lenten devotional we have booklets found on the grey table in the narthex from Lutheran Hour Ministries.

LENTEN MERCY: This Lent we will be working to support the crisis pregnancy centre: Our Lady of Guadalupe Home (OLOGH). OLOGH is the only residential home for young single mothers in Windsor. They have been open since 2013. Their centre can house up to 7 moms and their babies. Their biggest need at the moment is funding to replace mattresses, couches, stoves, dishwasher, etc. If you would like to contribute to OLOGH you can write it in on your offering envelope and Good Shepherd will forward the money to them.
